Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) and Montgomery College (MC) have an articulation agreement for **Child Development Associate Preschool Program** and **Early Childhood Education** programs. 3. Ask the high school registrar to attach a copy of your official sealed transcript to the Articulation Credit Award Form.
4. Print and sign your name below to signify that you have read the Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form and you understand the requirements of earning credit at Montgomery College (MC).
5.
