MONTGOMERY COLLEGE TRANSFER ADVISING BY MAJOR – PSYCHOLOGY Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science [BA OR BS] – Updated July 29. 2025

Transfer requirements for Psychology majors vary by school; check with each school of interest to determine which PSYC, MATH and Science courses are required. Consider MC's General Studies SSAH AA degree to select the Math and specific PSYC courses needed for transfer to the school(s) that interest you most.

UMD - COLLEGE PARK <u>PSYCHOLOGY BA or BS</u>
Required: PSYC 100 General Psychology
Lower-Level THEME courses: Take 1 course per Theme at

the 100/200- level @ MC (= three 200- level PSYC'S total); other major-requirement PSYC courses are taken after transfer to UMD at the 300- and 400-level.

THEME I: Mind, Brain, & Behavior – Choose one from PSYC 215 Child Psychology or 228 Psych of Learning

THEME II Mental Health & Interventions – One from: PSYC 204 Personality, 206 Hum. Sexuality, 207 Psych of Women, PSYC 221 Pathospsychology, or STSU 124 Happiness & Wellbeing (2 credits)

THEME III Social, Developmental, & Organizational Processes. One from: PSYC 211 Social, 216 Adolescent, or PSYC 224 Cultural Psychology

Other Requirements:

- BIOL 150 Principles of Biology 4 credit Lab Science, and a second Non-Lab Science (any), 3 credits, from MC General Education Program List.
- MATH 150 Elementary Applied Calculus, 4 cr.

PSYC 200 Statistical Methods in Psychology is taken after transfer to UMD, it has a UMD MATH 120 = **MC MATH 150** Applied Calculus prerequisite, therefore a STAT 100 = MC's MATH 117 Statistics course at MC is not needed.

The <u>Psychology major at UMD is an LEP - Limited</u> <u>Enrollment Program</u>. There are **3 Gateway courses** required for admission to the Psychology BA and BS:

1. PSYC 100, 2. BIOL 150 Prin of Biology, 3. MATH 150 Only one repeat of one Gateway course is permitted.

UMBC – PYSCHOLOGY BA U of MD, Baltimore Co.

Required: PSYC 100 General Psychology

Domains – take one course from each Domain:

- Social, Personality, and Abnormal: One course from PSYC204, PSYC211, or PSYC 221 Pathopsychology (formerly Abnormal) recommended.
- Development: One from PSYC203 Human Growth & Development, PSYC 215 Child Psychology recommended, or PSYC216 Adolescent Psychology
- Learning and Cognition: One from PSYC
 228 Psychology of Learning
- Culture, Diversity and Context: One from PSYC206 Sexuality, PSYC207 Psych of Women, or PSYC 224 Cultural Psychology

Other Requirements:

- MATH 117 Elements of Statistics only math required
- Two sciences: One Lab Science, one Non-Lab Science – can be any from <u>MC General Education</u> Program List.
- <u>UMBC requires completion of a single language</u> through the 201-Intermediate I level.

WHAT IF I TAKE MORE PSYC Courses AT MC THAN ARE REQUIRED?

You may take further PSYC's at MC beyond a transfer school's minimum lower-level requirements, however, additional 200-level PSYC's from MC will not reduce the number of 300- and 400-level PSYC courses that must be taken after transfer.
