Economics or Political Science Elective includes: ACCT221, ACCT222, ECON103, ECON105, ECON201, ECON202, POLI101, POLI105, POLI203, POLI206, POLI211, POLI221, POLI230, POLI242, or POLI252

Foreign Language Requirement: The language requirement consists of completion of a foreign language through the 201 level or demonstrated proficiency at that level. Proficiency, the number of courses needed to complete the requirement, and course placement, are determined by previous experience as follows: 1) completion of level 4 or higher of a language in high school, 2) corresponding AP, IB or CLEP credit, or 3) completion of a language through the 201 level at a regionally accredited college or university. The Shady Grove Foreign Language Transfer Credit Limit Exemption allows students to transfer up to 6 credits of foreign language above the 60 credit limit, provided that one of those courses is a the 201 level. Language credits may be completed after matriculation at UMBC at Shady Grove.

Minor Area of Study: UMBC's Social Work program requires a second area of concentration of at least 18 credit hours, such as another major, or a minor. At UMBC, at least six credits of the area of concentration must be upper-level. Maximum nine credits from MC can be used toward the minor at UMBC. Students attending UMBC at The Universities at Shady Grove may complete a minor in: **Sociology, Political Science, Psychology, History, or Public History**. Note: The minor in social welfare cannot be used to satisfy this requirement in conjunction with the social work major.
