

Montgomery College has been an anchor higher education institution in Montgomery County for more than 70 years, with significant regional reach and economic impact on the state of Maryland. Having a RISE Zone designation around its integrated academic, business, and research campus (PIC MC) in Germantown will accelerate the College's and the county's partnership efforts to leverage our best institutional assets to attract businesses and jobs where they are most needed in our community.

A Regional Institution Strategic Enterprise (RISE) Zone designation allows targeted businesses locating within PIC MC and connecting to Montgomery College to receive real property tax credits of 75 percent for five years.

The Germantown Campus has also been named an Opportunity Zone, which provides federal tax incentives to spur investment in underserved communities by attracting investment. These incentives can spur further economic development in the form of job creation and revitalization, providing new opportunities for business, housing, and retail growth.
